WHAT: “Bucky Pizzarelli Show:Join us in this exciting venture for the GSHC, presenting for the first time, at one of festivals, an opportunity to see the legendary guitarist, Bucky Pizzarelli and his amazing, bass player, Jerry Bruno, accompanied by the outstanding chromatic harmonicist, Enrico Granafei.

WHO: Bucky Pizzarelli....Paterson born, NJ guitarist, known as a legend in his genre, Bucky has played with Les Paul, Benny Goodman and Frank Sinatra and was guitarist for the Doc Severinsen Band on the Johnny Carson “Tonight Show.” He has released ten albums, played for Presidents Ronald Reagan and Bill Clinton and in 2005 was inducted into the ASCAP Jazz Wall of Fame. He has also played and recorded with Rosemary Clooney, Tony Bennett, Kate Smith, Sarah Vaughn, and Duke Ellington and has played with Ella Fitzgerald, Antonia Jobin, Stan Getz, Roberta Flack, Miles Davis, Lena Horn, Charles Mingus, Lionel Hampton, Hank Jones, Lou Rawls and many more!

Jerry Bruno.....Also widely considered a jazz legend, joins Mr. Pizzarelli for the performance. In his career he has backed Tommy Dorsey, Paul Anka, Louis Prima, Liza Minelli and Frank Sinatra. He has recorded with Tony Bennett, Don Costa and Stevie and Eddie. Jerry met Bucky in 1948 when they were both playing in Vince Monroe’s big band; they have been playing together ever since!

Enrico Granafei.....Harmonica virtuoso, classical guitarist, singer, songwriter, arranger, composer who followed in the tradition of the legendary Toots Thielemans, he began to explore new possibilities for the harmonica, an instrument too often associated solely with Rock and Blues. Besides playing in the best jazz clubs during that period, Enrico performed regularly on national television. His love for Jazz led him to New York City, the world capital of Jazz, where he performed at local jazz clubs, including The Blue Note, Birdland, Visiones, Angry Squire, and the Bottom Line. In 1992 Enrico earned a masters' degree in Jazz Performance from the Manhattan School of Music, the only student of Toots Thielemans. He also has a Masters Degree in Classical Guitar and has recorded with Eddie Gomez, Eliot Zigmund, Marc Johnson, Adam Nussbaum, Ted Curson, Nnena Freelon and many others. Enrico's latest accomplishment is his work on the Hands-Free-Chromatic Harmonica invented by Vern Smith allowing him to play Chromatic Harmonica and Guitar at the same time.
